RE: Remote Online Learning Years 9, 10 and 11

Dear parents and care givers,

I would like to take this opportunity to acknowledge and apologise that there has been some miscommunication between the school and families regarding remote online learning. I can appreciate that this has caused some families and students distress while we navigate this challenging time.

All students have been placed into a Google Classroom, attached to their Home Group teacher, from where they will be able to find links to schoolwork to undertake remotely and online. All students have been sent an invitation to join the Google Classroom from their Home Group teacher, and at this point in time the number of students who have interacted with this virtual classroom is exceedingly high.

Home Group teachers would have conducted a virtual home group this morning and have posted information as to student expectations.

To clarify, Department for Education guidelines, have stipulated those students in Years 9 and 10 are to undertake the following each day:

45-60 minutes of Numeracy (default is their core Math's class)

45-60 minutes of Literacy (default is their core English class)

45-60 minutes of another subject (Multi-Faculty/Elective subjects have published activities for students)

30 minutes of reading

30 minutes of physical activity

An online session will take place once a week, which will be communicated to students as to when this will occur via the Google Classroom.

Year 11 students are to engage with each subject one session per week, to be communicated with students by the subject teacher. These subjects are selected via the Google Classroom Home Group.

If you require further clarification, have questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact either the Home Group teacher, or the relative Year Level Coordinator (Kazic Neilson - Year 11 or Steve Carli-Seebohm – Year 9 and 10).
