## INFORMATION FOR 2022

Dear Families

We look forward to welcoming your child to Millicent High School in 2022 and hope the transition experience has been enjoyable and will contribute to a smooth transition into Secondary School.

As we prepare for the 2022 school year we would like to give you some important information relating to your child's transition to Millicent High School.

### Home Groups 2022

Home groups have been created for 2022 in close consultation with your child's Primary teacher with a focus on educational and wellbeing needs. After transition days, Millicent High School staff meet to discuss the Home Group configurations and changes may be made if required.

### Stationery Collection

Please find your child's 2022 Stationery List enclosed. The stationery list indicates what is required for Year 7 & 8 students in 2022. For your convenience, pre-orders can be placed with Millicent Newsagency from 3<sup>rd</sup> January 2022. Dates for collection will be advised when placing your order. \*Please note: If preferred, families may choose to purchase stationery elsewhere.

In 2022, Year 7's and Year 8's will have the opportunity to attend a year level camp. Information regarding location and cost will be distributed in Term 1 2022.

### Fee Payment

<b>MHS Logo T-Shirt:</b> (To be worn at all times with the exception of PE lessons)	Available <i>exclusively</i> at Since Fifty Six
<b>Shorts:</b> (Plain navy blue with no visible logo or brand name)	Available at Since Fifty Six in a variety of styles.
<b>Trackpants:</b> (Plain navy blue with no visible logo or brand name) <b>Leggings are not acceptable.</b>	Appropriate options are available at Since Fifty Six and Sportspower.
<b>Please Note: All plain navy blue trackpants are acceptable providing there is no visible logo or brand name</b>	
<b>Jeans:</b> (Blue denim- full length or ¾ jeans)	
<b>MHS Logo Jumper:</b> (Woollen and hooded options available)	Available <i>exclusively</i> at Since Fifty Six
<b>MHS Logo Jacket (optional):</b>	Available <i>exclusively</i> at Since Fifty Six
<b>Senior Jumpers:</b> (Reviewed annually, to be worn by Year 12 Students only)	Ordered in consultation with Year 12 Students
<b>Summer Dress:</b> (Must be worn at an appropriate length)	Available <i>exclusively</i> at Since Fifty Six
<b>Winter Skirt:</b> (Must be worn at an appropriate length)	Available <i>exclusively</i> at Since Fifty Six
<b>PE T-Shirts:</b> It is compulsory for Year 8-10 students who study Physical Education to wear their PE tops in practical lessons. Year 7 and 8 Students will be issued with a PE top in Home Group on Day 1.	Replacement PE tops for all year levels are available for purchase from the school.
<b>Footwear:</b> For reasons of safety and hygiene, open sandals, slides, ugg boots and thongs are <b>NOT PERMITTED</b> . Sturdy footwear is required in all workshop areas.
